

32. 1789, JANUARY 9. 33. 1792, MARCH 3 Indian cession of lands at Presque Isle including the Triangle.

On October 3, 1788, an Act was passed authorizing the Supreme Executive Council to draw on the State Treasurer for a sum of mone of purchasing from the Indians lands on Lake Erie. It is usually called the "Purchase of the Triangle." It contains 202,187 acres.

13. 1696, JANUARY 13.

14. 1697, JULY 5.

Taminy's deed for the lands between Permopeck and Neshaminy, and "as far back as a horse can travel in two summer days."

15. 1700, SEPTEMBER 13.

Deed of the Susquehanna Indians for the lands on "both sides of the Susquehanna and next adjoining the same, and comprising Dongan's Deed." (No. 13).

17. 1718, SEPTEMBER 17.

Deed of release by the Delaware Indians for "the lands between the Delaware and Susquehanna Rivers, from Duck Creek \*\*\* to the Lehigh Hills."
